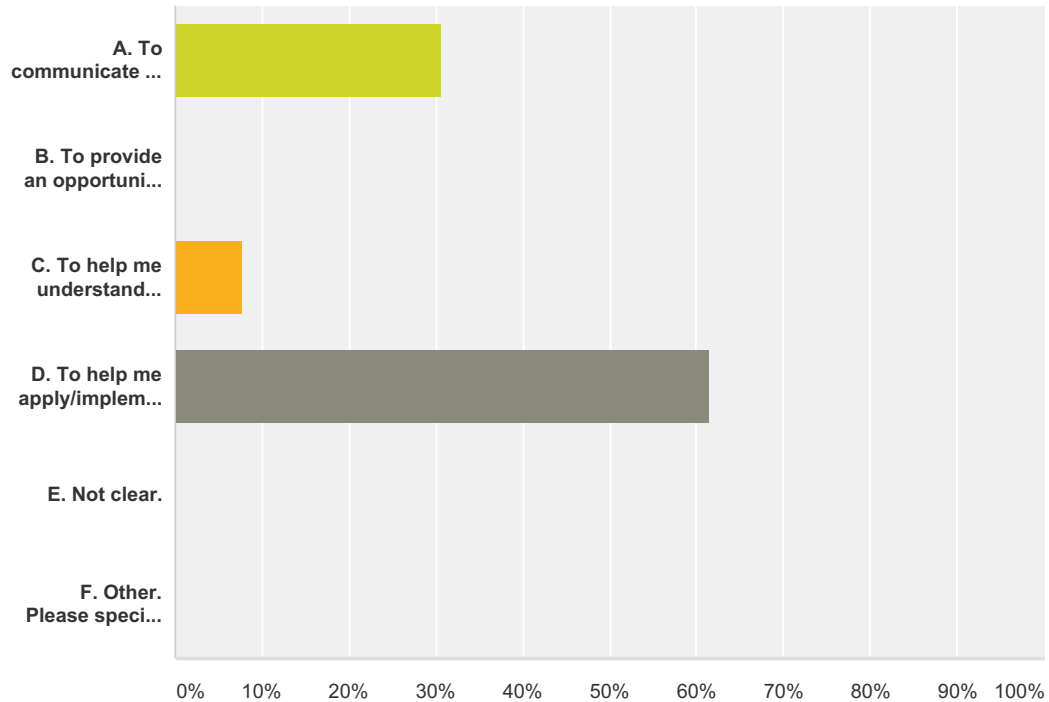


Q1 Which of the following statements best describes the primary purpose of the "Now What?" workshop. Please select only one. The main purpose of this workshop was

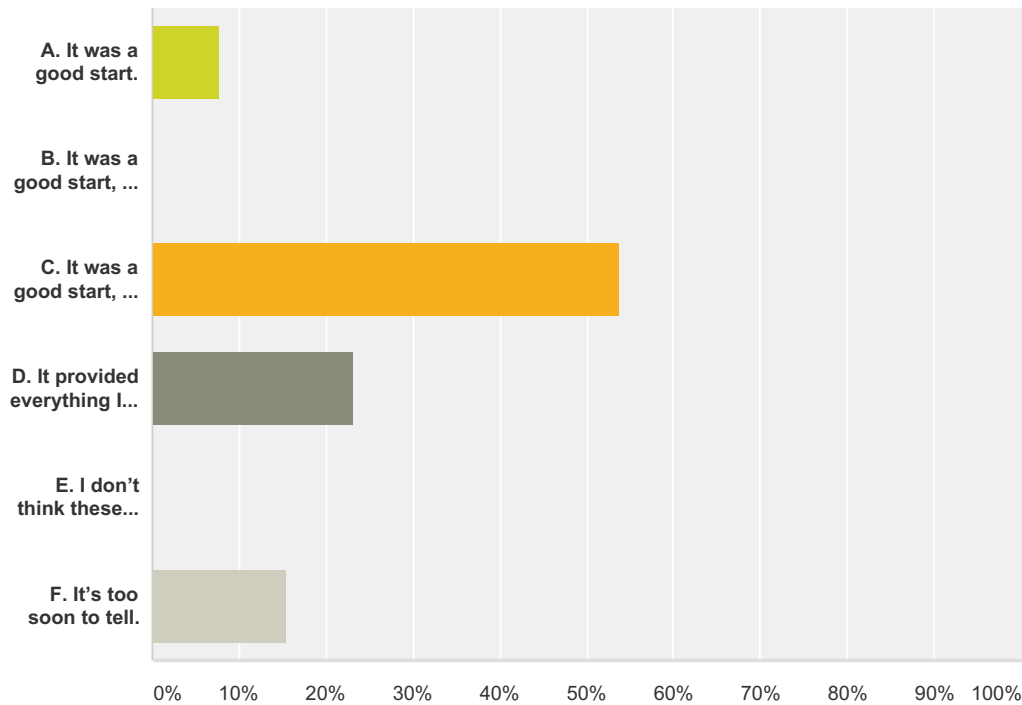

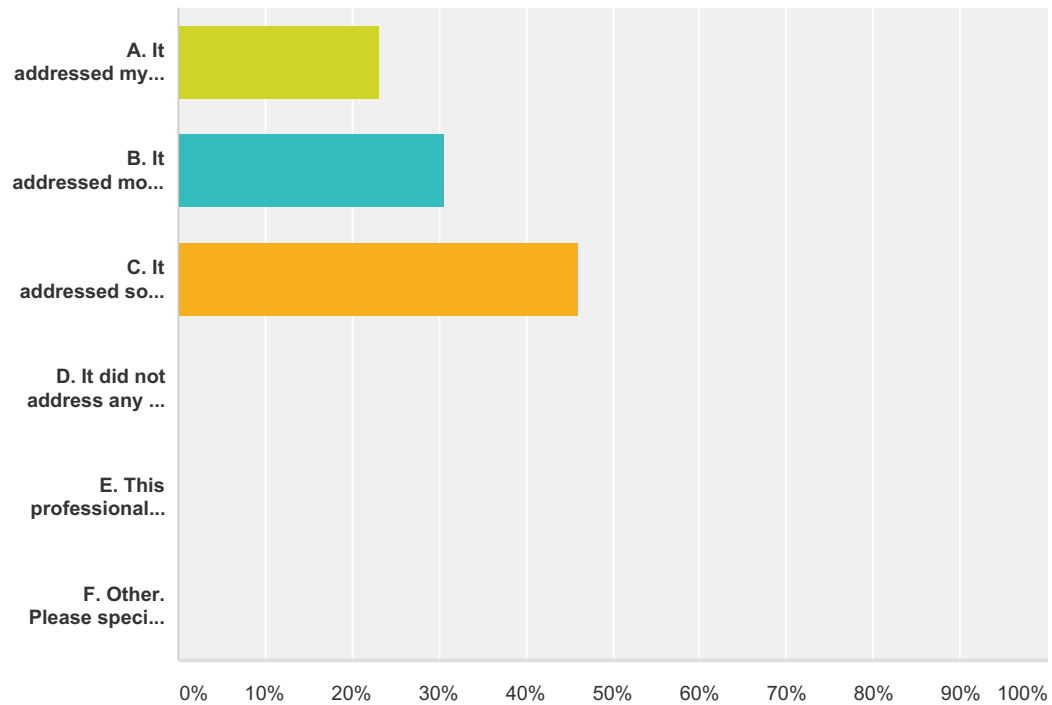

Q3 Indicate the extent to which "Now What?" workshop met your professional learning needs. Please select only one.

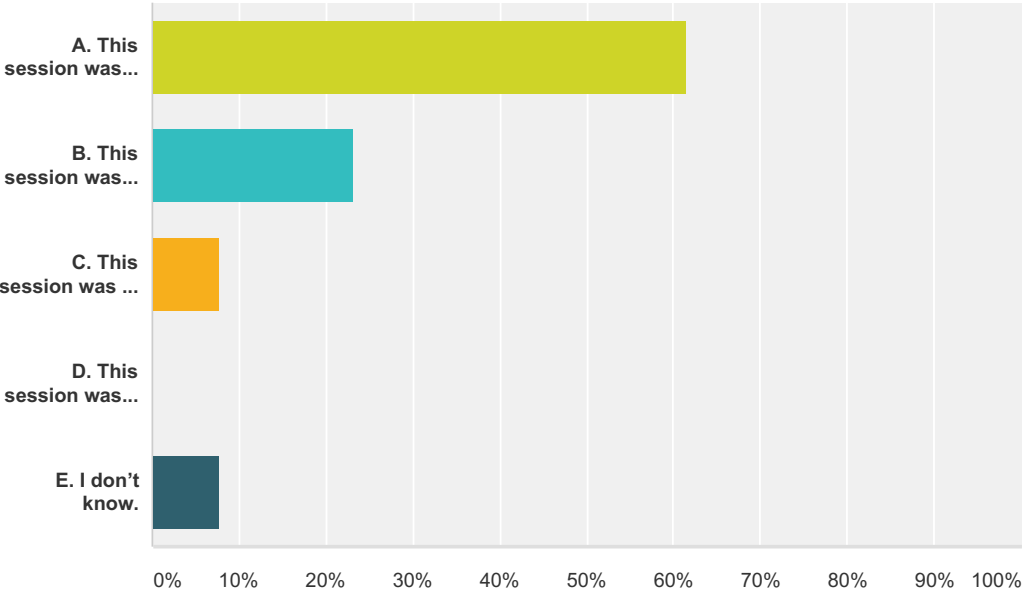

Q4 To what extent was this session aligned with your school or district’s school improvement goals or efforts?

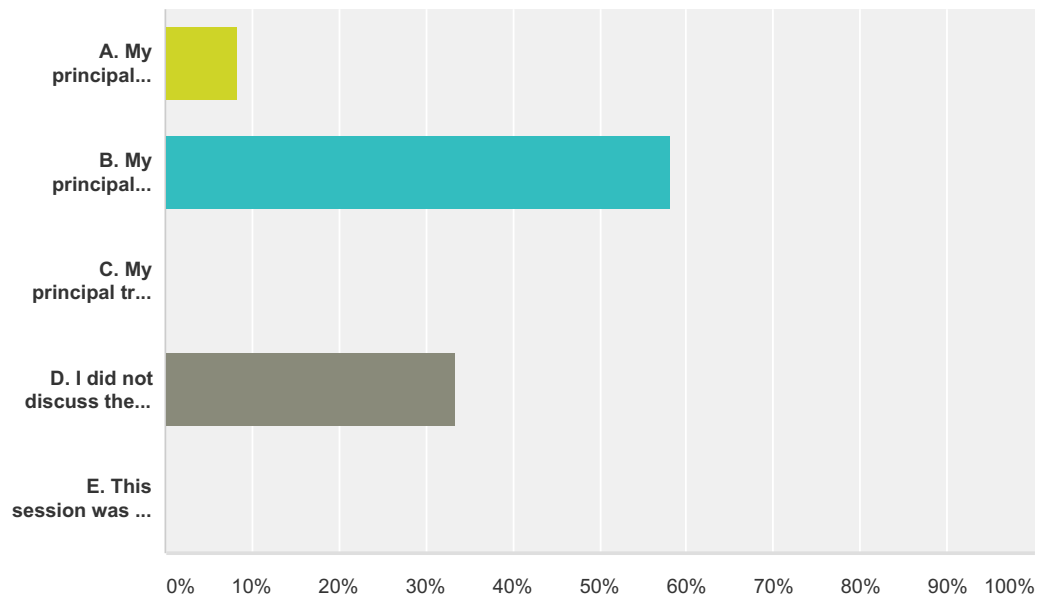

Q5 Which of the following statements best describes the support you received from your building principal to participate in this professional learning?

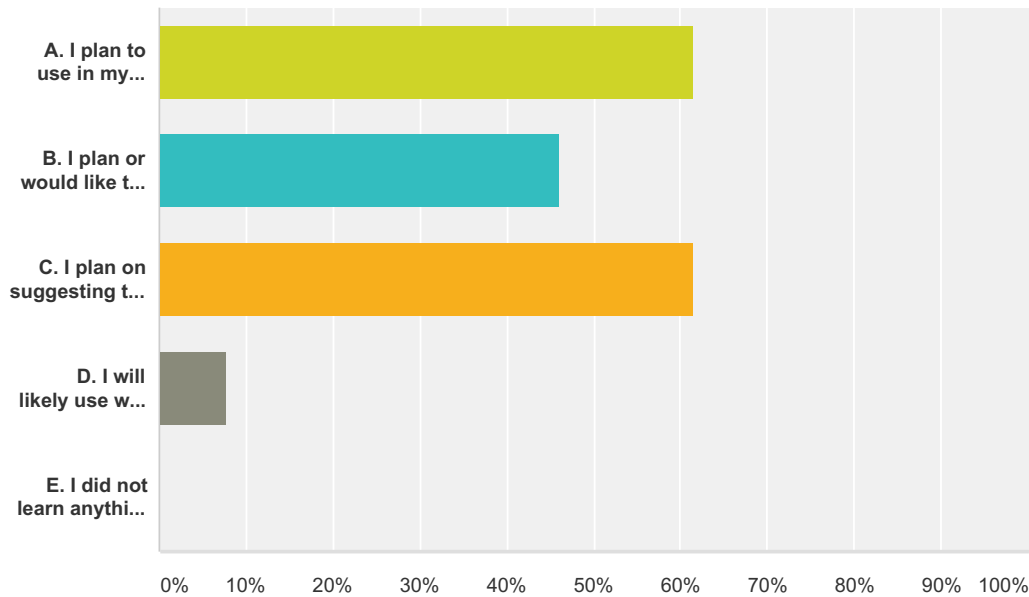
