Educators participating in these 7 sessions will learn how to:

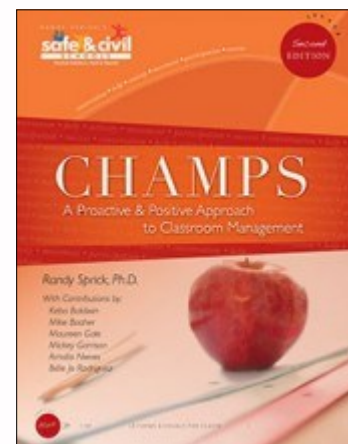
- Structure their classroom for success,
